How to get there

From Barcelona Airport (T1):

- To Sants hotels: Direct train via R2 line (~35 min)
- To Plaça Espanya hotels:
 - o Aerobus: ~37 min
 - o Train R2 line: ~35 min + 5 min walk

From Hotels to AMB:

- Direct bus connections:
 - o From Sants: Bus 109
 - o From Plaça Espanya: Buses 109 or 23

From AMB to Tomorrow. Mobility (Expo):

- Direct buses: 109, 23, or V3
- Travel time: ~5 min by bus + ~5 min walking

From vanAPEDAL to AMB:

- Step 1: Walk to Av. Marquès de l'Argentera Pg. Picasso (~1 min)
- Step 2: Bus H14 to Paral·lel Drassanes
- Step 3: Bus 21 to Area Metropolitana de Barcelona (AMB)
- **Total travel time:** ~35 min
